

**CITY OF SEA ISLE CITY, NEW JERSEY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, JULY 10, 2012 – 10:00 AM
COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

ATTENDANCE: Mr. Divney, Mr. Edwardi, Mr. McHale, Ms. Tighe and Mr. Kehner. Also attending was Mayor Desiderio, Administrator Mr. Savastano and Solicitor Mr. Baldini.

Council President Kehner called the meeting to order and asked everyone to rise for the flag salute and prayer. He then announced that the meeting had been advertised in accordance with P. L. 1975, Chapter 231.

Mr. Kehner then asked for a motion to adopt the minutes of the 6-26-12 Regular Meeting. Motion moved by Mr. McHale and seconded by Mr. Edwardi. All ayes followed.

REPORTS-Mayor and Administrator: Mayor Desiderio commended the Fire Department and Ambulance Corps in controlling a boat fire at the marina on Monday.

The Mayor also announced that he and Senator VanDrew met with NJ Transit and that as of July 7, 2012; the bus will once again come into Sea Isle and pick-up/drop-off on JFK Blvd.

REPORTS-Council: There were no Council reports.

ORDINANCES – Second Reading and Public Hearing:

Mr. Kehner asked for a motion to take up Ordinance 1523 for second reading and public hearing. Motion moved by Ms. Tighe and seconded by Mr. McHale. All ayes followed. The clerk read the ordinance by title: **1523 – An Ordinance to Amend Chapter VII of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Sea Isle City to Reflect Changes Necessary to Allow for Safer and More Efficient Navigation of City Streets.** Mr. Baldini provided an overview of the changes.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Patrick Martin, Esq. – Representing Angelo Camano: Opposed the removal of section 7-7.4 c. as a 1992 agreement extended Mr. Camano's driveway as parking. He added that a lawsuit has been filed.

Angelo Camano-116 45th St., Owner Angelo's Restaurant: Stated he has received dozens of tickets in a place he has been parking for over 20 years and he feels it is harassment and a violation of his civil rights.

Mr. Baldini stated that the ordinance does not affect Mr. Camano's rights and without getting into the litigation, in 1992 under a revitalization plan, his drive way was reconfigured to accommodate trucks and that the recent reconstruction Mr. Camano had the same request and the driveway was accommodated.

Mr. Kehner then asked for a motion to adopt ordinance 1523 on second reading. Motion moved by Ms. Tighe and seconded by Mr. Edwardi. All ayes followed.

CITIZEN COMMENT-Resolutions on Consent Agenda: There was no citizen comment on the resolutions.

Mr. Kehner asked for a motion to adopt resolutions #129 to #134. Motion moved by Mr. Edwardi and seconded by Mr. McHale. All ayes followed.

NEW BUSINESS: There was no New Business

CITIZEN COMMENT:

Steve Tyman-Owner of Jamaican Me Crazy: Suggested that all of the parking permittees be notified about the rules, i.e. that you cannot park on Landis Avenue all day.

Ann Organ-209 39th St: Thanked the lifeguards who provided first aid due to a cut, but suggested the first aid kit be replenished as that was the last band-aid. She also announced that the Town Watch/Town Pride newsletter had a misprint and that the Meeting will be Thursday, 7-12-2012 at 7:00 pm.

Alan Fisher-122 55th St: Praised Public Works employees that helped him recently, suggested there were some bad areas along Central Avenue since the construction was complete and police need to enforce cars overhanging driveways into sidewalks and there is a need for more pedestrian cross walk signs. Mr. Kehner advised that Central Avenue is not complete and the contractor will be back in the Fall.

Dave Helfrich- 21 36th St: Stated he complained two meetings ago about five properties in need of clean up and he was referred to Mr. Teefy, but nothing has been done. Mr. Savastano said he would follow up.

Irene Jamison-1500 Landis Ave: Complained that the Jitney service ends at 29th St. Mr. Kehner said they will drive beyond if requested, but she feels there should be a pick-up too. He said he would ask if at least one every hour drive down to 1st. She next said she received a flyer soliciting orders for SIC Flags and the City should put something in the Newsletter letting everyone know they are not “official flags”.

Mr. Kehner asked for a motion to adjourn. Motion moved by Mr. Edwardi and seconded by Mr. McHale. All ayes followed and the meeting adjourned at 10:35 a.m.
