**ORDINANCE NO. 1639 (2019)**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEA ISLE CITY, CHAPTER 7 SECTION 22 ENTITLED “LOADING AND UNLOADING PROHIBITED ON BAY STREET CURBS” PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF “NO LOADING OR UNLOADING” ZONES ON OR AROUND BAY STREET ENDS**

**WHEREAS**, there is loading and unloading of goods and materials by commercial vehicles/boats on Bay Street curbs; and

**WHEREAS**, the loading and unloading of goods and materials in undesignated zones can be a serious hazard to the public health and welfare, safety and quality of life; and

**WHEREAS**, this loading and unloading of goods and material by commercial vehicles/boats on Bay Street curbs threatens to impede in the future the ability of fire trucks and ambulances to access the area as required to respond to emergency and fire calls; and

**WHEREAS**, this loading and unloading of goods and material by commercial vehicles/boats on Bay Street curbs can cause, among other things, excessive noise and congestion in an area not designated or designed for such activity; and

**WHEREAS**, the City shall establish no loading or unloading at the Bay Street curbs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recommends no loading and unloading on all sides of Bay Street curbs and from the Bay in the best interest of the public safety (except for governmental vehicle(s) and emergency personnel, which shall include firemen, first aid squad members and police officers); and

**WHEREAS**, the sections of the roadways in question are wholly contained in the City of Sea Isle City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City hereby regulates loading zones on streets and portions thereof pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, appropriate police powers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Sea Isle City, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION I.** Chapter 7 Section 22 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Sea Isle City, entitled “Loading and unloading Prohibited on Bay Street Curbs” is hereby amended to add the following section in its entirety as follows:

**ADDED SECTION:**

**7-22 LOADING AND UNLOADING PROHIBITED ON BAY STREET CURBS.**

**SECTION II.** Chapter 7 Section 22.1 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of

Sea Isle City, entitled “Loading and unloading Prohibited on Bay Street Curbs” is hereby amended to add the following section in its entirety as follows:

**ADDED SECTION/STREET:**

**7-22.1 Loading and unloading Prohibited on Bay Street Curbs from/to Boats.**

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any commercial vehicle/boat at any dates/times to cause the loading or unloading of any goods and materials whatsoever from/to a boat on all City owned Bay Street curbs, upon all sides, from or to the Bay, the curbs adjacent to, or in the general proximity of Bay Street curbs or any other place on, at, or near the Bay Street curbs.

**SECTION III.** Chapter 7 Section 22.2 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Sea Isle City, is hereby amended to add the following section in its entirety entitled “Enforcement and Penalty” as follows:

**ADDED SECTION:**

**7-22.2 Enforcement and Penalty.**


This section and provision shall be enforced by the Sea Isle City Police Department or any other law enforcement agency having jurisdiction to enforce traffic provisions of the State of New Jersey. Violations of this section shall be punishable as set forth in Chapter 1, Section 5, in the discretion of the Municipal Court Judge.

**SECTION IV. Severability.** If for any reason any section of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining section of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, notwithstanding.


**SECTION V. Repealer.** Any Ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION VI. Publication.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the adoption and publication in accordance with the law.
