Beaches may reopen or return to their original placement (85th Street stand back to 86th Street, 50th Street stand back to 51st Street, 39th Street stand back to 40th Street, 60th Street stand back to 59th Street, 76th Street stand back to 75th Street and 91st Street stand back to 92nd Street) on Saturday, September 4, 2010 if manpower permits.

All beaches with lifeguards on duty will be closed for the season on Labor Day, Monday, September 6, 2010 at 5:00 PM. Selected beaches may be reopened for weekends in September.

Certain beaches may be opened earlier, or closed later, in the season depending upon need and availability of lifeguards.

Guards will be in attendance from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday thru Friday and from 10:00 AM to 5:30 PM on Saturday and Sunday, unless otherwise indicated. Beach Badges are required.

Saturday August 14, 2010 all beaches with lifeguards on duty will close at 5:00 PM in order that the City may host the Captain Bill Gallagher Island Run.
