

**CITY OF SEA ISLE CITY, NEW JERSEY
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
SATURDAY, MAY 16, 2015 – 9:00 A.M.
COUNCIL CHAMBERS
SEA ISLE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL**

ATTENDANCE: Mr. Gibson, Mr. Kehner and Acting Council President Ms. Tighe. Also attending was Administrator Mr. Savastano. **ABSENT:** Mr. Edwardi and Mr. Divney

Acting Council President Ms. Tighe called the meeting to order and asked everyone to rise for the flag salute and prayer. She then announced the meeting had been advertised in accordance with P. L. 1975, Chapter 231.

Ms. Tighe then asked for a motion to adopt the minutes of the 4-28-15 Regular Meeting. Motion moved by Mr. Kehner and seconded by Mr. Gibson. All ayes followed.

REPORTS-Mayor and Administrator: Mr. Savastano reported that the beach fill project is now in operation in Strathmere, heading north until it relocates to Avalon in June and should be back to the north end of Sea Isle around the end of July. He also reported that the outfall pipes at 82nd and 86th Streets are being replaced now, before the sand from the beach replenishment covers them.

Mr. Savastano reminded everyone that updates are on the website and when the pumping begins in Sea Isle, there will be daily updates on the schedule.

Mr. Kehner asked about the mobi-mats as there is a rumor that all of them have been sold. Mr. Savastano said none were sold, but they will only be placed at handicap access beaches this year. After the restoration of the beach walkovers that will occur with the beach fill project, an assessment will be made next year to determine the need of mobi mats.

REPORTS-Council: Mr. Kehner provided a photo of Ben Jargowski's Eagle Scout project, a memorial to honor fallen SIC police officer, Michael Cullinane at 26th Street.

Mr. Gibson suggested complaints received by the Council regarding the SIC Blvd. or T.I. Bridge be forwarded to the County. Mr. Savastano said he always sends them to the County and frequently follows up with a phone call.

Mr. Gibson next asked when 46th Street paving will be done and Mr. Savastano said he believed it was the fall, but will confirm it with an e-mail to all of Council.
