CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES  
FRIDAY JULY 10, 2015 – 8:00 AM  
COUNCIL CHAMBERS

**ATTENDANCE:** Mr. Divney, Mr. Kehner, Ms. Tighe and Mr. Gibson. **ABSENT:** Mr. Edwardi.

Council President Gibson called the meeting to order and announced that the meeting had been advertised in accordance with P. L. 1975, Chapter 231.

**CITIZEN COMMENT ~ Resolution No. 122.** There was no public comment on the resolution.

**RESOLUTION:**

**122 – Authorizing the Issuance of a License to Conduct Amusement Games**

Mr. Gibson then asked for a motion to adopt the Resolution No. 122. Motion moved by Ms. Tighe and seconded by Mr. Kehner. All ayes followed.

Mr. Decredico thanked the Council for taking action as he was taking the application to Newark this morning so that his Amusement License could be renewed.

Mr. Gibson then asked Council if there were any items to be discussed or considered. He said that he wanted to make sure the “complete streets” program does not get lost as he feels strongly that the City should push less vehicular and more bicycle traffic. Mr. Divney said it will be included in the Master Plan re-exam. Ms. Tighe said she wanted to be sure the Master Plan addresses the size of homes and all the associated factors.

Mr. Gibson also suggested Mr. Divney and Mr. Kehner, liaisons to the Planning Board and Tourism Commission respectively take opportunities at Council meetings to report on the on-going activities of both. Mr. Gibson went on to ask if Council wants to continue to receive the police noise reports and all said yes. He then said he was going to ask the Administration for more frequent beach tag revenue reports and Mr. Divney said he would like MUA flow reports as all agreed in August to look at Water & Sewer flows, rates and use of utility surplus funds.

In conclusion, Mr. Gibson said he would ask the Administration for an update on a T.I. Bridge meeting with Avalon, the CMC Engineer, Bridge Commission and Mayor/Freeholder Desiderio regarding continued work scheduled for the winter of 2016.

**CITIZEN COMMENT:** There was no citizen comment.

Mr. Gibson then asked for a motion to adjourn. Motion moved by Mr. Kehner and seconded by Ms. Tighe. All ayes followed and the meeting adjourned at 8:20 a.m.
